


Streicher/ Strings	
	Kratzend. Bei leiser Dynamik erreichbar durch langsame Bogenführung und/oder leichteres kratzen. Der Endklang soll in Nuancen den Musikern überlassen, einzig soll die Bogenführung nicht so langsam sein, dass Untebrechungen entstehen. Scratchy. For lower volumes this can be achieved by slower boing and/ or softer scratching. Nuances of the final sound should be decided by the musicians, the bowing speed however must not be too slow and produce brakes.
	Wenig, weniger Bogendruck (je nach Situation oder Spieltechnik wie beispielweise <i>flaut.</i>) / Neutraler, normaler Bogendruck (analog zu <i>ord.</i> Anweisung). Less, lesser bow pressure (depends on the situation or playing technique such as <i>flaut.</i>) / ordinary bow pressure (also <i>ord.</i> instruction).
	Slap mit der Greifhand, je nach Anzahl der Saiten mit Hand oder Daumenaußenseite. Ohne staccato nicht auf den Saiten verweilen, so dass Nachklang entsteht. Slap, kein Tap! Slap with gripping hand, depending on the number of strings with the outer side of the thumb only. If no staccato is given, release string after tapping to prevent sound damping. Slapping is not tapping!
<i>loco</i> <i>ord.</i>	<i>loco</i> bedeutet, der Instrumentalist gewöhnliche Spielposition verwenden soll und hebt demnach spezifische Positionsangaben wie <i>s.p.</i> <i>s.t.</i> <i>sul D</i> etc. auf. <i>ord.</i> wie gewohnt. <i>con sord.</i> Wird nicht aufgehoben! <i>loco</i> denotes that the player should use ordinary playing positions again. It thus revokes instructions such as <i>s.p.</i> <i>s.t.</i> <i>sul D</i> etc. <i>ord.</i> as usual. <i>con sord.</i> remains valid.
<i>flaut.</i>	Schnelles Streichen direkt am Griffbrett bei leichterem Bogendruck. Ergibt je nach Lage und Art des Tones eine flötenartigen Klang. Faster bowing right at the fingerboard. Depending on pitch and playing technique, this results in a flute like sound.
	Auf dem Steg über Saiten streichen. Rauschgeräusch. Bowing strings on the bridge. Produces noise.
<i>F</i>	Glissando nur mit flageolet-Finger. Gilt nur für aktuelles Gliss. Perform glissando only with flageolet-finger. Only valid for current gliss.
 (Portato-staccato)	Note am Ende ihrer Dauer mit absetzen, zwischen Portato und staccato. Stop sound at end of note's duration like a mix of portato and staccato.

	Arco glissando plus pizz., letztere als kopfplose Noten notiert in relativ beliebiger Höhe zu spielen mit der Greifhand. Die Distanzen der Noten zueinander implizit schwache Zeit und Höheninformationen enthalten. Arco glissando plus pizz, the latter denoted by headless notes and to be played at rather arbitrary pitch with the gripping hand. Implicit, weak information about pitch and onset of the pizzicato is given by the respective distances between notes.

	Cluster.
	Saiten in Inneren des Flügels mit Hartgummischlägel anschlagen. Gleichzeitig mit beispielweise einem Korken in Pfeilrichtung auf den Saiten entlangwandern. Strike strings in the inner of the instrument with a hard rubber mallet. Simultaneously slide, for instance, a cork along the strings in the direction indicated by the arrow.
pizz/plec	Egal welche der Anweisungen gegeben ist: mit Plectrum in Inneren des Flügels Saite(n) ggf. wie ein Arpeggio zupfen. Der zweite Satz hat hierfür der Übersicht halber teilweise ein eigenes System. Either of the instructions means: Plug string(s) in the inner of the instrument, if necessary similar to an arpeggio. In the second movement for reasons of clarity, there is an additional staff for this technique.
	Pedalisierung ist bis auf explizit ausgezeichnete Stellen dem Instrumentalisten überlassen. Bitte Pedal nicht zurückknallen lassen. Pedalization is, except for distinguished parts, left to the instrumentalist. Please do not let bang the pedal.

	Triller i.A. mit Halbton oberhalb, hier mit Halbton unterhalb. In general, trills are to be played with halftone above, in this case with halftone below.

General: Accidentals barwise!
